Michael J. Rusnak began his career as a Trial Attorney with the Internal Revenue Service District Counsel's Office (1977-82). He is an experienced litigator in representing clients before the IRS, the Indiana Department of Revenue, and the Courts in civil and criminal tax matters.

He is a past Chair of the Taxation Sections of the Indiana State Bar Association (1995-96), Indianapolis Bar Association (1988), and IRS Central Region Bar Liaison Group (1993-94). He has also served on the IRS Regional Counsel Bar Advisory Group for the IRS Central Region (1991-92). He has been a past speaker on IRS procedures in programs sponsored by the ABA, Indiana State CPA Society, Indiana Continuing Legal Education Forum and IRS Chief Counsel's Office. Prior to attending law school, Mike served on active duty as a 1st Lieutenant with the U.S. Marine Corps and retired from the Marine Corps Reserve as a Lieutenant Colonel in 1993.
